THIS AGREEMENT Made and entered into by and between Helen B.

Dougherty, by C. E. Briscoe, Attorney-in-Fact, hereinafter referred to as "Party of the First Part", and J. H. Mauldin, D. U. Mauldin and Martha C.

Vess, hereinafter referred to as "Parties of the Second Part",

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H:

The Party of the First Part hereby grants unto the Parties of the Second Part the right and privilege to use the 12-foot strip running along the Southern line of Lot No. 4 back to a depth of the property owned by the Parties of the Second Part as a private driveway, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) The Parties of the Second Part agree to surface treat said alley-way at their own expense, and to use it only for the purpose of serving the building owned by them erected on Lot No. 5.
- (2) It is distinctly understood and agreed that by the use of said alley by the Parties of the Second Part, or their Successors-in-Title, that no right shall accrue by way of adverse possession, prescription, or otherwise; and that the Parties of the Second Part will maintain said alley-way
