All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville and Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the Southwest side of Heather Way and being known and designated as Lots #123, 124, 125 and 126, of Marshall Forest as shown on plat thereof by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated October, 1928, and recorded in the R.M.C.
