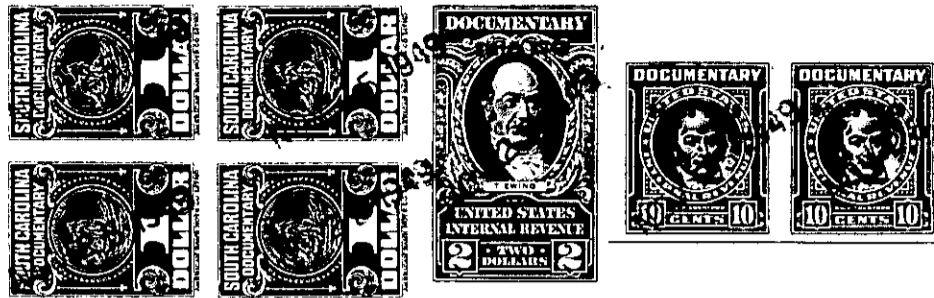

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, Max W. Goodlett and Addie M. Cooke Owen, individually and as Executrix u/w/o C. E. Cooke

in the State aforesaid. in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by C. W. Cason and C. L. Morgan

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. W. Cason and C. L. Morgan,

their Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the North side of Endel Street, being known and designated as lot No. 29 on Hudson's Map, dated November 1, 1871, containing one (1) acre, more or less, and being the same land conveyed by Samuel C. Lewis to C. E. Cooke and W. J. Goodlett by deed dated July 9, 1913, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 23, page 21. This is the same land shown on County Block Book as lot No. 5 of Block No. 7, page 123, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the North side of Endel Street, joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 7, and running with line of lot No. 7 215 feet, more or less, to Southern Railway right-of-way; thence with said right-of-way 155 feet to a point, joint corner of lots Nos. 3 and 5; thence with line of lot No. 3, 199.3 to a point on the North side of Endel Street; thence with Endel Street, 155 feet to the beginning corner.
