all of the interests of the Plaintiffs and Defendants in that lot of land containing 4.69 acres, more or less, being the same property conveyed to Alice J. Gunn by deed of H. P. McGee, W. P. Conyers and W. T. Hend erson, Trustees, said deed dated May 18, 1918, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.
