BEGINNING At a stake at the Southeast corner of the New Buncombe Road and Marlin Street and running thence with the Southern side of Marlin Street, N. 58-30 E. 160.9 feet to a stake on Paris Mountain Road; thence with the Western side of Paris Mountain Road, S. 16-17 E. 77.7 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 59; thence with the line of said lot, S. 58-30 W. 182.5 feet to a stake on the New Buncombe Highway; thence with the Eastern side of New Buncombe Road in a northerly direction 80 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
