in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Annie T. Henderson, her heirs and assigns forever:

All those two certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District 7-I, now within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 107 and 108 of a subdivision known as "Nicholtown Heights" as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 4, and having such metes and bounds as shown on said plat.

And also Lots Nos. 1, 19 and 20 described as follows:

All those certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, School District 7-H-1, now within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1, 19 and 20, of Block C, of a subdivision known as "Glenn Farms", as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 75, and having such metes and bounds as shown on said plat.

The above property was conveyed to me as follows:

(1) Lot No. 107 is the same conveyed to me by N. O. McDowell, Jr. by deed dated July 10, 1944, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 265, page 228; (2) Lot No. 108 was conveyed to me by C. B. Martin by deed dated August 26, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 236, page 321; (3) Lot No. 19, Section C, is the same conveyed to me by Robert Henry by deed dated June 30, 1947, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 318, 88; and (4) Lots Nos. 1 and 20 were conveyed to me by N. O. McDowell, Jr. by deed dated June 18, 1945, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 279, page 320.

These lots are conveyed subject to rights-of-way granted to Duke Power Company for power lines.

The grantee is to pay taxes for 1950.
