The following described property: All that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land, lying, situate and being on the East side of Buncombe Road, State and County aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Euncombe Road, being the Southwest corner of B. F. Grant's lot, and running thence with Buncombe Road S. 4-17 E. 52.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 87-40 E. 207.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. h-17 W. 52.5 feet to an iron pin, being the rear corner of lot of B.
