

Clark, their heirs and assigns, all of that certain lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate on the Scuth East side of Alaska Drive (formerly Morningside Drive), in the city and county of Greenville, South Carolina and known and designated as lot No. 3 on plat of Parkview, which plat is recorded in the RMC Office in Plat Book M at page 49 and more particularly here described, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Alaska Drive at front joint corner of lots 3 and 4, said pin being 375 feet in a Northwesternly direction from the point where the Southeast side of Alasks Drive intersects with the Northeat side of Neely Drive and running thence with the line of No. 4 S 36.17 E 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N 53.43 E 50 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot No: 2; thence with the line of that lot N 36.17 W 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Alaska Drive; thence with the Southeast side of said Drive S 53.43 W 50 feet to the beginning corner.
