


OO W 100 feet to a stake on the East side of Robins Street; thence along the East side of Robins Street S12-00W 59 feet to a stake, the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed by G. A. Norwood to Elizabeth Johnson, December 19, 1898, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Deed Book FFF, at page 294. Subsequently, Elizabeth Johnson died intestate and the grantor, Beatrice Johnson, her only child and sole heir, inherited the above described property. This property was subsequently conveyed by the grantor to Elizabeth McDavid, who thereafter, reconveyed the property to
