All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of Stewart Street, being known and designated as a portion of Block K, "Kanatenah", a plat of which Subdivision is recorded in the R.
