KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That WOODSIDE MILLS, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter referred to as Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty-Six and 11/100 (\$2,336.11) Dollars, in hand paid by DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New Jersey, hereinafter referred to as Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and deliver unto the said Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, the following described property, easements, rights and privileges, to-wit:

(1) The following personal property:

- (a) The electric distribution lines and system of the grantor located in and serving the mill village near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, owned by the grantor, including fifty-eight (58) poles, nine (9) crossarms, twenty-four (24) braces, three hundred and ninety-nine (399) bolts and lag screws, three hundred and sixty-six (366) racks, sixty-eight (68) 3-bolt guy clamps, eight hundred and thirty-nine (839) insulators, four hundred and twenty-seven (427) wire holders, screw, six (6) meters, and approximately ten thousand, nine hundred and one (10,901) pounds of wire. It is understood that the personal property constituting a part of such distribution lines and system other than that aforementioned shall remain the property of the grantor and may be disposed of as it sees fit.
- (b) The electric distribution lines and system of the grantor located in and serving the mill village located in the Town of Simpsonville, Greenville County, South Carolina, owned by the grantor, including two (2) poles, one hundred and seventy-six (176) bolts and lag screws, two hundred and twelve (212) racks, fifty-five (55) guy clamps, four hundred and forty (440) feet of guy wire, twelve (12) strain insulators, two hundred and seventy-five (275) insulators and wire holders, and approximately five thousand three hundred and forty-nine (5,349) pounds of wire; together with all apparatus and equipment forming a part of the street lighting circuit serving said village. It is understood that the personal property constituting a part of such distribution lines and system other than that aforementioned shall remain the property of the grantor and may be disposed of as it sees fit.
- (c) Approximately twelve hundred and twenty-two (1222) pounds of wire, constituting a part of the electric distribution lines and system of the grantor located in and serving the mill village located within the Town of Fountain Inn, South Carolina, together
