BEGIF ING at an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 3 on said plat, and running thence with line of Lot No. 3, N. 32-30 W. 625.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 36-15 E. 95 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 1; thence with line of Lot No. 1, S. 32-30 E, 641.4 feet to iron pin; and thence S. 45-35 W. 90 feet to beginning corner.
