TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises and properties before mentioned unto the said A. Ralph Todd, As Trustee, his successors and assigns, in trust for the following uses and purposes to-wit:

- (a) To manage, rent and control all of the real properties paying all necessary expenses incident thereto including taxes, insurance and farm operating costs and to collect and receive all rents and income.
- (b) To sell the same or any portion thereof from time to time on such terms as to him may seem fair and adequate and to execute and deliver to the purchaser or purchasers good and sufficient deeds.
- (c) To pay and discharge all expenses of the administration of the Estate of F. M. Todd, Deceased including all takes or assessments payable against the properties of the estate, all inheritance and income taxes payable to the State of South
