ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SIMPSONVILLE, S. C. Granting to Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc., an Exclusive Franchise for the Construction, Maintaining and Operation of Its Telephone System In, Under, and Over the Streets and Other Public Places and Property of the Town of Simpsonville, South Carolina.

WHEREAS, it is deemed to the Public Interest to grant to Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc. the exclusive right to operate its telephone system over the street and other public places and property in the town of Simpsonville for a period of Twenty-five years from the date of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the town council of the Town of Simpsonville in meeting assembled:

SECTION 1. That Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc.
its successors and assigns be, and are hereby granted the exclusive right,
privilege and franchise to conduct a telephone business within the town of
Simpsonville, S. C. for a period of Twenty-five years from this date.

SECTION 2. That Home Telephone Company of Simpsonville, Inc.
its successors and assigns, be and are hereby granted the exclusive right
and privilege to use the streets, sidewalks, alleys and other public places
and public property in the town of Simpsonville for the purpose of maintaining and operating a telephone service, and for precting and maintaining its poles, wires, transformers, conduits, and other fixtures or apparatus
