

in the State aforesaid, That Joseph F. Schotta and Largare the Schotta FARNSWORTH (\$22,000.00) - in consideration of the sum of --Twenty-two Thousand and R.M.C.

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. F. Cato, Sr., his heirs and assigns, all that piece, purcel or lot of land in Butler Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, situate just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville on Wabster Road, known and designated as Tracts Nos. G and H, according to a plat of the property of the Sinking Fund Commission, District 17-A, made by C. M. Furman, Jr., April 1933, which plat is recorded in the R.L.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "H", at Fage 219, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Webster Road, joint corner of Tract H and Lot Will, which iron pin is 208.4 feet in a Westerly direction from Laurens Roud, and running thence along the Northwestern side of Webster Roud S. 51-18 W. 630 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Tracts F and G, and running thence along the joint line of said tracts N. 47-03 W. 465.8 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of said lots; thence N. 59-22 £. 588.9 feet to the rear joint corner of Tracts E and H and Lots 5 and 6; thence S. 55-35 E. 405.5 feet to the point of beginning.

The herein named Grantee is to pay the 1950 taxes on the above described property.


