All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Bates Township, in the northern part of the town of Marietta, on the East side of Cleveland avenue, which avenue is on the East side of the G. & N. railway, and having, according to a survey made by T. T. Dill, Surveyor, on March 17, 1948, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
