All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Fairview Township, near the Town of Fountain Inn, S. C., lying on the North side of Georgia Road and C. & W. C. Railway and adjoining a tract of land being conveyed to the grantee herein by John Richard Vaughn and Irene McGee Vaughn, and having, according to a plat of property of Fairview Mills, near Fountain Inn, S. C., prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, May 23, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the North side of Georgia Road, which iron pin is 762 feet in an Easterly direction from the center line of C. & W. C. Railway, and running thence N. 63-44 W. 1,060.4 feet to an iron pin, corner of property being conveyed to the grantee herein by John Richard Vaughn and Irene McGee Vaughn; thence with the line of said property, S. 22-15 W. 1,093.5 feet to a point in the center line of C. & W. C. Railway; thence with the center line of said Railway, the following courses and distances: N. 72-57 E. 78.3 feet, N. 74-31 E. 100 feet, N. 76-36 E. 100 feet, N. 78-33 E. 100 feet, N. 80-33 E. 100 feet, N. 82-37 E. 100 feet, N. 84-36 E. 100 feet, and N. 86-14 E. 55.1 feet to an iron spike in the center line of said Railway and the Northern side of Georgia Road; thence leaving said Railway and running along the North side of Georgia Road as the line, N. 58-14 E. 591.6 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the North side of Georgia Road, N. 56-28 E. 170.4 feet to the beginning corner.
