

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southern side of Croft Street, being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 48, Section C, according to a plat of the property of Stone Land Company which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at pages 337-345 and having, according to a more recent plat, of said property, which latter plat was made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in August, 1950 and which latter plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Z" at page 13, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Croft Street, which iron pin is 100 feet in a southeasterly direction from the southeastern intersection of Townes Street and Croft Street and running thence along the southern side of Croft Street S. 83-13 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 6-06 W. 200 feet to aniron pin on the northern side of an abandoned alley; thence along the northern side of said abandoned alley N. 83-13 W. 48.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-00 E. 94 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83-13 W. 2.9 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 47, Section C; thence along the line of Lot 47, Section C, N. 6-06 E. 107.2 feet to the point of beginning.
