All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, known and designated as the western half of lot No. 24 of the Louise Earle and India E. Pepper property according to a plat made thereof by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, May 1947 and having according to said rlat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Gordon Street, the front joint corner of lots Nos. 23 and 24, which iron pin is 210 feet west from the southwest corner of the intersection of Gordon and Owens Streets and rurning thence with the joint line of said lots S. 10-15 E. 200 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of lot No. 29; thence with the rear line of said lot N. 79-45 E. 35 feet to a point in the middle o" the rear line of lot No. 24; thence runing through the middle of lot No. 24 M. 10-15 W. 200 feet to a point on the south side of Gordon Street; thence with the south side of said street S. 79-45 W. 35 feet to the beginning corner.
