All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on both sides of the Watkins Bridge Road, in Paris Mountain Township, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to a survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, October 24, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Watkins Bridge Road, at corner of lands

of Crawford W. Hester and Mary B. Anderson, which road leads from U. S. Highway No. 25 to Montague, and running thence along the center of said Watkins Bridge Road with the Hester line, N 35-0 E 197.3 feet to a point in the center of said Watkins Bridge Road; thence continuing with the Hester line, N 43-49 W 159 feet to an iron pin; thence N 22-OLE 1835.42 feet to an iron pin; thence S 63-26 E 878.26 feet to an iron pin; thence S 7-30 E, crossing the Watkins Bridge Road, 1668.26 feet to an iron pin; thence S 45-46 E 118.45 feet to a point in the center of Brock Creek; thence down Brock Creek following the center line thereof, S 46-05 W 310.5 feet to a point; thence continuing down the center of Brock Creek, S 37-16 W 238 feet to a point; thence still with the center of Brock Creek, S 42-06 W 471.04 feet to a point; thence continuing with the center of Brock Creek, S 42-31 W 151.5 feet to a point in center of creek; thence N 44-16 W 1422.10 feet to a point in the center of Watkins Bridge Road, the beginning corner, and containing 75.739 acres.
