

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That...... I, M. Alice Childers,..... in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Nine Thousand Three Hundred dight ... by..... Furman University

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said. Furman University, its successors and assigns, forever:

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on both sides of S. C. Himway 23-83, leading from the Watkins Bridge Hoad to the Duncan Chapel Road, in Paris Mountain Township, Orponville County, South Carolina, being shown as Tract 5, on plat made by J. F. Bowers, C. S., August 31, 1936, recorded in the R. H. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "I", at page 63, and having, according to a survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, December 7, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNIng at an iron pin on Southwest edge of S. C. Highway 23-EC, corner of lands now or formerly of Jessie E. League, and running thence with the Jessie E. League property, S 37-31 W 178.86 feet to an iron min, line of property now or formerly of Nannie Miller Moody; thembe with the Moody line, N 77-53 W 447.59 feet to an iron pin at corner of land now or formerly of L. Roy League; thence with the L. Roy League property, N 4-09 E 199.42 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the L. Roy League property, N 53-52 E crossing S. C. Hichway 23-88, 711.73 feet to an iron pin, corner of property of Crawford League; thence along the line of property of Crawford League, S 64-56 & 1585.88 feet to an iron pin; thence S 21-51 w 505.19 feet to an iron pin, corner of property now or formerly of Jessie 4. League; thence with the line of Jessie E. League property, N 66-19 W 1423.50 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest edge of S. C. Highway 23-88, the beginning corner, and containing 23.27 acres, more or less.

An interest in the above property was inherited by the Grantor from her lather, G. M. A. Lea we, who died intestate May 26, 1929, as will more fully appear by reference to Apartment 244, File 30, Pro-Dato Court, Greenville County, S. C., and an interest was devised to the Crantor under the will of her mother, Hattie K. League, who died testate February 9, 1936, as will more fully appear by reference to Apartment 364, File 1, said Probate Court, and the romaining interest in said property was conveyed to the Grantor by Ers. H. Stella Phillips et al, by deed dated May 20, 1937, recorded in the R. H. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 198, at page 445.

It is agreed that the Seller shall occupy the premises until December 31, 1950, and shall have until that date to gather any and all crops situate upon said premises.
