in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eugene E. Stone, III, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, on the South side of Piney Mountain, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone and running thence S. 77 1/2 E. 2.4 chains, more or less, to the corner of a tract conveyed by C. C. Jones to the Piney Mountain Land Company by deed recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 26, at page 240, and running thence along the line of the last mentioned tract, N. 52 3/4 E. 11.00 chains to a dogwood at the north corner of said last mentioned tract; thence continuing along the same course, N. 52 3/4 E. 16.50 chains to a stone; thence N. 35 W. 7.43 chains to a stone; thence S. 45 3/4 W. 15.60 chains to a stone; thence S. 38 1/4 W. 14.40 chains to a stone, the beginning corner, and containing 14.33 acres, more or less, as shown by plat made by W. A. Adams, D. S., October 3, 1913.
