

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, P. O. Batson, Merzie B. Sammons, Lois B. Watson, Venie B. Fleming, W. T. Batson, Cecil B. Barr and Myrtle B. Byrd,

in the State aforesaid,

sum of Five thousand nine hundred and fifty (\$5950.00)..... Dollars

Katherine B. Bridwell

in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said

Katherine B. Bridwell:

All of our right, title and interest, the same being seven-eighths undivided interests, in and to that tract of land situate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing fifty acres, more or less, and being bounded North by lands of Sammons; East by lands of Sammons; South by lands of Bridwell; and West by lands of Brookshire.

Said tract of land is composed of those two parcels conveyed to our father, the late Joseph Batson, by two deeds, of record respectively in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County in Deed Book GGG at page 361 and Deed Book LLL at page 426, and our said father having died testate and by his Last Will and Testament having devised the same unto the grantors and the grantee in equal shares.
