

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Trotter, being shown as all of Lots 7 and 8 on plat of Property of Jones accrory, et al, prepared by W. A. Hudson, D. S., Feoruary 26, 1906, and having according to a recent survey and plat of Property of John P. Datson, et al, by J. C. Hill, L. S., February 17, 1951, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
