Robert Arnold Knight:

All of two (2) certain tracts of land situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, and in Dunklin Township, to wit: One hundred and sixty and 42/100 (160.42) acres, more or less, the same being known as the West tract, and being described as follows: Beginning at a stone 3x at southwest; thence N. 80½ E. 79.00 to a stone 3x, formerly bounded by the Thos. W. Austin tract; thence N. 29½ W. 29.20 to a stone 3x; thence S. 68¼ W. 43.33 to a poplar 3x; thence S. 79 W. 25.15 to a stone 3x; thence S. 4½ W. 18.18 (probably is S. 4½ E. 18.18) to the beginning. Bounded now by lands of Will Scott, krs. Harley Campbell, G. Felton Taylor, Robert A. Knight, and the one acre tract described below. Also, all of one acre, more or less, joining the above described tract on the south.
