BEGINNING at a stone on public road and running N. 41 W. 10.50 chs. to poplar; thence S. 36-30 W. 11 chs. to a red oak; thence S. 23-30 W. 24.25 chs. a point in the branch; thence N. 50-30 E. 7.25 to a stake; thence S. 12 E. 4.75 chs. to a hickory, old corner; thence N. 16 E. 9 chs. to a post oak, old corner; thence N. 20-30 E. 20.70 chs. to a pine; thence N. 9 E. .94 links to the beginning corner and containing 34 - 1/4 acres, more or less, according ro a revised plat prepared by B.
