KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That C. F. HAYNSWORTH, JR., AS ADMINISTRATOR D. B. N. C. T. A. OF THE ESTATE OF H. J.
HAYNSWORTH, DECEASED, W. W. BURGISS CHARITIES, INC., AN
ELEEMOSYNARY CORPORATION ORGANIZED AND EXISTING UNDER THE LAWS
OF THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, HAROLD DEAN BURGISS, JR. AND
SHUMAN B. GERALD, JR., in the State aforesaid, in consideration
of the sum of SIX HUNDRED (\$600.00) DOLLARS, to them in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by JOE A. KING (the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said JOE A. KING:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Grove Street and running through to Springer Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lots 11 and 24 on a plat of the property of H. H. Harris made by William A. Hudson March 21, 1908, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 225, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southern side of Grove Street at the joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11, and running thence in a Southerly direction 200 feet, more or less, to a point on the Northern side of Springer Street, the joint front corner of Lots 23 and 24; thence along the Northern side of Springer Street in an Easterly direction 50 feet, more or less, to a point, the joint front corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence in a Northerly direction 200 feet, more or less, to a point on the Southern side of Grove Street, the joint front corner of Lots 11 and 12; thence along the Southern side of Grove Street in a Westerly direction 50 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

The above described lot is composed of that property conveyed to H. J. Haynsworth and W. W. Burgiss by H. H. Harris by his deed dated October 7, 1938, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-ville County in Deed Book 209, at page 90, and of a portion of that property conveyed to W. W. Burgiss and H. J. Haynsworth by Floride Rhodes by her deed dated August 18, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 36, at page 137.
