County, State of South Carolina known as tract 7, containing 1.00 acre, of the estate of J. B. Hawkins, Sr. according to the survey made and drawn in January, 1949, and the metes and bounds thereof being in the civil plat as follows:

Begins at a point on the north line of the said tract 7, Paris Mountain Golf Course 24 feet from line. In Martin's corner of tracts 7 and 8 on the old mill stream, thence west 100 feet along line of tract 7 to a point 17 feet from stream, thence S 1-30 E 100 feet along line of tract 7 to a point 30 feet from stream, thence N 60-00 E 100 feet to a point 100 feet from stream, thence N 1-30 E 31.3 feet across County road to a point 100 feet to point of beginning, being a portion of the tract deeded to J.
