FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is

MOTOR TRANSPORT CORPORATION

THIRD: That the principal place of business is

COLUMIDIA, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to own and operate a motor vehicle transportation-for-hiro business and freight forwarding business in interstate, intrastate, and foreign commerce; to own, lease, (as lessor or lessee) hiro, and operate motor freight vehicles; to transport and have transported for hire, general freight in interstate, intrastate, and foreign commerce; to own, lease (as lessor or lessee), and buy, sell, and deal generally in real and personal peoperty and do all things incident thereto; to lend and borrow money, with and without security; and to do any and all things incident and incidental to the operation of the business aforesaid.
