City Land & Improvement Co., which plat is recorded in Deed Book VV, at page 542, RMC Office, Greenville County, S.C. and having according to a survey and plat of property of Harry H. Palm prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engs., September 7, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Wilton Street, which point is 150 South of the intersection of Wilton Street and West Stone Avenue and is the common corner of property of the Grantor and lot now or formerly of S.T. Earle: thence along property now or formerly of Annie H. Smith and S.T.
