industrial community; and to make and establish other appropriate rules and regulations governing the use of such facilities. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that so long as the property hereby conveyed or any substituted property is impressed with the trust herein set forth, it shall not be utilized for the purpose of profit or gain, and no part of the activities for which said property is utilized shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or attempting to influence legislation; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that in case of the death or resignation of any one or more of the above named Trustees, the remaining Trustees or Trustee shall have the power and authority to name an additional Trustee or Trustees to fill such vacancy or vacancies, or to enlarge the number of Trustees and the Trustee or Trustees so named or appointed, in conjunction with those previously qualified and still acting at the time shall have all the powers, rights, and authority hereby vested in the above named Trustees.

And the said Board of Trustees does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said L. P. Hollis, C. H. Thomas and Ray W. Bayne, as Trustees, their successors, successors in office and assigns, against itself and its successors.
