

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Pennsylvania Avenue in the Village of the Greer Plant, Victor-Monaghan Company, near the City of Greer, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Victor Monaghan Co., Greer Plant, Greer, S. Brannon; thence along Brannon's line S. 14-22 W. 144.7 feet to an iron pin on a 15 foot alley; thence along said 15 foot alley N. 75-19 W. 104.6 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot 178 of the grantor's property; thence along said Lot 178 N. 13-19 E. 129 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
