The State of South Carolina. The State County of Greenville.

WHEREAS the undersigned Pete J. Pleconas and R. Ernest Dalton of the State and county aforesaid, are in the Plumbing busines, by and under the name of P. J. Plumbing Company, the place of business being situate near to and the business area being in and around the city of Greenville,

AND WHEREAS both of said partners are married and the wives are living, their names being Grace Pleconas and Maude Dalton, respectively,

AND WHEREAS it is the desire of the partners composing the above named business to make provision, in the event of the death of either of said partners during the life of their respective wife that the share such partner as shall become deceased, be upon his death, become the property of said respective wife and to that end it is hereby agreed:

That no assignment, sale or transfer of the interest of either of the aforementioned partners shall be had without the written consent of the wife of the one making such sale or transfer, and, further, at the death of either of said partners, his undivided inter@ est in said partnership and all of its assets shall be and belong to the wife surviving such partner and the partner living shall see to such transfer and agree to and acquiesce therein to the end that said business may be continued in operation under the same or any other agreed to name, and the parties then in interest shall be the wife of such deceased partner and the surviving partner and in the event the one thon surviving shall become deceased, , then under the trrmas hereof, said surviving wives shall be the owners of said business. That by and with the consent of said wives or by and with the consent of the surviving pather and the wife of either deceased, or if both present partners are deceased, then the respective wives of each being the owners may sell and convey said business or close it out and discontinue the same at their discretion.
