All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, or Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and known as Lot No. 8 of Block 2, in subdivision known as Park Place; 1st lot No. 8 of Block 2 of Park Place, as shown by plat on record in the ....C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 11, page 119, said lot being each fifty feet on Second Avenue the remaining side in parallel lines one hundred and fifty feet, and being the same lot of land conveyed to J.
