POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, Ollie Farnsworth, do hereby
appoint H. S. French, my attorney, for me and in my name to sue, defend, sue for,
collect, recover and receive all sums of money, debts, dues, demands, claims,
bills, interests, dividends, annuities and demands whatsoever which now or
shall hereafter become due, owing, payable or belonging to me, or mine, use and
take all lawful ways and means in my name or otherwise for the recovery thereof,
by attachments, arrests, distress or other due, and to compromise, sue for
the same, and acquittances or other sufficient discharges for the same, for me,
and in my name to make, seal and deliver; to bargain, convey, lease for, buy,
sell, mortgage, hypothecate, and in any and every way alienate or dispose of
goods and merchandise, choses in action, the other property, in possession or in
action, and to reduce mortgagor on land or chattels, and to make, enter into and
set up every kind of business of that nature and kind however it may be
and except the receipt or possession of all money till account therefor received,
the same, to, by, cause, barter, bargain, sell, lease, convey, mortgage, hypothecate
lands, tenements and hereditaments, upon such conditions as follows, and under
such cover as, as he shall think fit and also for the recovery of the same
and to sue, defend, execute all writs, summonses, processes, executions,
and assignments of leases, agreements, covenants, bonds, bills, hypothecations,
bottomries, charter parties, bills of sale, bills, notes, due, receipts, witnesses
of acts, releases, and satisfaction of mortgages, judgments and other titles, and
such other instruments in writing or otherwise as may be necessary
or proper in the premises. Giving and granting unto H. S. French, my attorney
and his substitutes or substitutes, full power and authority, to do and perform
all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and
about the premises, or relating to the interests and purposes of I might be enabled
to do if personally present, I hereby ratifying and confirming all that H. S. French,
said attorney, or his substitutes or substitutes, shall lawfully do or cause to
be done by virtue of these presents.
