All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situ te, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, St to of South Carolina, on the southeast side of Rockwood Drive, and being shown as all of Lot 78 on plat of Section A of Rockwood Park, prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Impineers, August 24, 1948 (as revised October 5, 1948), which plat is recorded in Fl.t Book S, at pages 168-169, R.M.C. Office, Greenville County, S.C., and reving according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:
