## WITNESSETH

Toohey certain property situate at the Northwestern corner of the intersection of East McBee Avenue and Spring Street, Greenville, S. C., said property fronting on East McBee Avenue a distance of 127 feet more or less and having a depth along its Eastern and Western boundaries of 148.8 feet more or less, and

WHEREAS, by an assignment dated September 29, 1951, the said E. S. Toohey assigned unto Central all of his right, title, and interest in the aforementioned lease and Central now occupies said premises as lessee with the following exception:-
