

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.E. WILLIAMS & I.H. PHILPOT, AS TRUSTEES FOR J.E. WILLIAMS, I.H. PHILPOT & J.A. WYATT, Their Successors and Assigns Forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of the Parker Road and the South side of a new road leading from Monaghan Mills to the White Horse Road, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing approximately 5.8 acres, and having according to a recent plat and survey entitled "roperty of Bera Realty Co.," surveyed by John C. Smith, et al., Reg. L.S., in March, 1952 (to be recorded herewith) the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin near the center of the intersection of the Parker Road and un-named surfaced treated road leading from Monaghan Mills to the White Horse Road, and running thence along a line near the center of said Parker Road, S. 26-15 E.351.1 feet to an iron pin; thence leaving said Parker Road, S. 57-05 W. 693.00 feet, more or less to an iron pin; thence N. 39-30 W. 351.1 feet to a point near the center of said un-named surfaced treated road leading from Monaghan Mills to the White Horse Road; thence along a line near the center of said un-named road, N. 57-05 E. 774.00 feet, more or less, to point of beginning.
