Violation of any of the above restrictions shall entitle the grantor or any owner of property in said subdivision to injunctive relief and to damages.

The grantee or his successors in title shall be liable to pay for any water tap made on the water line now available to the within described lot, it being understood that the grantor herein shall be relieved of such liability as contained in deed to the grantor by Talmer Cordell, recorded in Deed Book 442, at page 415, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
