C. Franklin by James A. McDaniel by deed dated Feb. 16, 1906 and recorded in the Office of REC for Greenville County in Book RRR, page 613. It begins at an iron pin in the Conestee Toad at corner of lot previously conveyed to David Valentine and running thence along Valentine N. 75% E. 6.00 to iron pin; thence S. 25 E. 4.00 to corner on lot being conveyed to Mary Montgomery; thence along the line of the Montgomery lot S. 75% W. 7.77 to corner in Conestee Road; thence along that road M. 2 W. 4.00 to beginning corner.
