

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Clate Davis,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by George Williams and Rosa Louise Williams

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George Williams and Rosa Louise Williams their heirs and assigns, forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as a southern portion of Lot No. 26 on Glenn Road, as shown on a plat thereof by H. B. Brockman, Surveyor, August, 1943, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H" at page 75, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 26 and 25 on the northwest side of Glenn Road, and running thence with the common line of said Lots, N.32-45 W. 80.13 feet to a stake in said line; thence N.87-30 W. to an iron pin in the joint line of Lots Nos. 27 and 26; thence with the common line of said Lots, S.34-30 E. 101.1 feet to an iron pin on Glenn Road, joint front corners of Lots Nos. 27 and 26; thence with Glenn Road, N.62-00 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning, and being the southern one-sixth portion of Lot No. 26 as shown on the Plat above referred to.
