I, Walter L. McCarrell, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$1.00) to me in hand paid by this instrument, do hereby constitute and appoint my brother, Henry E. McCarrell, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, to act and do for me and in my name and on my behalf all the business and matters as I might be able to do under my authority, in and to the purposes of and with authority and jurisdiction in and to the premises and the property hereafter designated:

I do hereby authorize and direct my attorney-in-fact to execute unto the Federal Land Bank of Columbia in my name, place and stead a note or notes in the sum of One Thousand Hundred Dollars (\$1000.00), payable to the order of the Federal Land Bank of Columbia in accord with such terms and conditions as he may see fit and as he may be required by the said Federal Land Bank and to expend the proceeds of such loan as he may think best and proper. And my said above mentioned attorney-in-fact is further authorized and empowered and instructed to sign for and in my name any receipts, endorse any checks, drafts or other instruments and to do any and all further acts that may be required or be necessary to complete the transaction without any one dealing with him being responsible or seeing to the application of the proceeds of the said loan.

The property which my attorney-in-fact is authorized to control is described as follows:

All that piece, parcel and lot of land being and being in Highland Township, County and State aforesaid, on waters of Mush Creek and on the new Tugaloo Road containing 66.67 acres, according to a plat made by J. Mac Richardson and being bounded on the north by Mrs. Clarence Roe, on the east by Mrs. Roe and Mrs. Barton, on the south by Barton, Yeargin, Noe and on the west by Noe and McCarrell. Said land is described by courses and distances on the plat recorded in Plat Book 9, Page 168, R. C. C. Office, Greenville County. Said land was conveyed to Walter L. McCarrell and Henry E. McCarrell by deed from Edna Mae McCarrell and others dated April 3, 1946, recorded in Book 292, Page 410.
