C.", made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., on June 7, 1948, revised June 15, 1948, and August 7, 1948, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at pages 173-177, inclusive. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 39 <u>Smythe</u> and fronts thereon____91

The grantor and its predecessors in title have granted unto Parker Water and Sewer Sub-District, Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C., Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, Greenville Traction Company, Duke Power Company and its predecessors, Southern Power Company lines, including all pipe (other than house water and sewer lines), valves, fittings, hydrants, manholes, poles, wires, transformers, regulators, and other apparatus village known as Dunean Mills Village in which the above described lot is located together with rights of way and easements to go upon the land for the purpose of maintenance, repair, alteration, replacement and operation (including meter reading) of the lines and systems aforesaid and of certain other water, the streets and alleyways located in Dunean Mills Village and to operate and maintain the lines as one store that the purpose of maintenance of purpo

This conveyance is made subject to the following restrictions:

- (1) That no mercantile establishment, other than those already in existence, shall be erected, operated or maintained on the lot above described.
 - (2) That only one residence shall be erected or maintained on any one lot.
