THIRD: That the principal place of business is

GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

to engage in the general entertainment, notion picture, ta kir micture, drive-in, and vaudeville theatre business, including, buying, a cling, renting and handling in any manor whatever of any or a life of or kines of equipment, service, and simplies that are in any de more or moment cannected with or related to the operation of any kind of ent rtain nt, show or theatre; that is to own, lease, and ranage establishments or enterprises for the purpose of offering and furnishing to the public for compensation or otherwise, motion pic ire, talking picture, vaudeville or any other form of entertainment, or any item or kind of equipment, service, or supplies that are in any degree or manner connected with show or theatre; to conduct all or any such business or enterprises upon whatever terms and at whatever rates the company wishes, with a right and power to act either as an agent or as a principal with the authority to buy and sell anything whatever and with the privilege of conducting business in Greenville, South Carolina, or any city or cities whatever. And in order properly to prosecute the objects and purposes above set forth, corporation shall have full power and authority to purchase, lease and otherwise dispose of all kinds of property, both real and personal, both in this state and in all other States, Territories and dependencies of United States; to purchase the business, good will and all other proof any individual, firm or corporation, as a going concern, and to all its debts, contracts and obligations, provided said business is and by the powers contained herein; to construct, equip and maintain to works, factories and plants; to install, maintain and operate all kinds of machinery and appliances; to operate same by hand, steam, water, electric other motive power, and generally to perform all acts which may be design necessary or expedient for the proper and successful prosecution of the objects and purposes for which the cer
