Also, all that other piece, parcel, and lot of land shown upon the Dalton and Neves plat of November, 1952, but not included in the metes and bounds heretofor set out, and having the following metes and bounds:

Commencing at a point on the western side of the right of way of South Carolina Highway No. 291 and approximately in the center of the old roadbed, and running thence along the western side of Highway No. 291 S8-49E 551.6 feet to a point on the western side of said highway; thence S89-18W 87.8 feet to a point in the old roadbed; thence N9-06W in the old roadbed 185.6 feet to a point; thence in about the center of the old roadbed N5-08E 364.2 feet to the beginning point.

The above lot of land is the same that was conveyed to Bob Jones College, a corporation, by Y. P. McCarter by his deed dated July 15, 1946, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in deed book vol. 295, page 437.

Also, all that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the northwestern side of Super Highway No. 29, being shown as lot no. 6 on plat of the property of Lula B. Green, made by Dalton and Neves in July, 1939, said plat being recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book B, page 112, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwest side of the right of way of Super Highway No. 29, at joint corner of lots no. 6 and 7, and running thence with the line of said lot no. 7, N7hW 435.6 feet to an iron pin on a 30 foot road, as shown on said plat; thence with the eastern side of said road N6-10E 157.2 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said 30 foot road N43E 75 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot no. 5; thence with the line of said lot no. 5 S42E 529 feet to an iron pin on the right of way of Super Highway No. 29; thence with the north-west side of said right of way S43W 200 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

Certain property restrictions are on this property as shown by the deed to Bob Jones College. This is the same piece of property which was conveyed to Bob Jones College, a corporation, and its successors and assigns, by A. B. Green, Ruth G. Shealy, and Lois Green by their deed dated July 22, 1946, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in deed book vol. 296, page 395. Reference is made to this deed for the property restrictions.
