

All that certain parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Brentwood Drive, being known and designated as Lot No. 11, Section F, of a revision of a portion of Croftstone Acres, and being as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book Y at page 91, and also as shown on a more recent plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S. C. Dated February 5, 1953, entitled "Property of Cline L. Bennett, Greenville, S. C.," and having according to said plats the following metes and bounds; courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Brentwood Drive (formerly Mitchell Street), which iron pin is 213.1 feet from the intersection of Brentwood Drive and Olwell Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, Section F, of said subdivision and running thence along the common line of said lots S. 52-49 W. 186.3 feet to an iron pin; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 11 and 17, Section F, S. 29-38 E. 51.7 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11, Section F; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots N. 64-42 E. 183.7 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Brentwood Drive; thence along the Western side of Trentwood Drive along a curved portion thereof, the chord of which curve runs N. 28-34 W. 90 feet to an Iron pin, the beginning corner.
