McLaheon, or 101 North Franklin Road, Greenville, South Carolina, my attorney for me and in my name and on my behalf to do and execute all or any act, deed and thing, as fully as I might or could do if personally present.

Such as to execute, acknowledge, and cause to be recorded any and all instruments which it may be necessary or desirable for me to execute including contracts of sale conveying the title to any property owned by me or in which I have any interest, present or contingent.

Such as to surrender or cast any overcoat, hat, or other items, that I do now have or my hereafter acquire, and to use the proceeds as he may deem necessary.

Such as to sell all or any part of my goods, wares, merchandise, and stock in trade as now or at any time hereafter I may have and possess on such terms and such amounts, and at such time, as my attorney may deem best, given unto my said attorney full power to make sales by himself or by his agents.
