WHEREAS, the said property was subsequently subdivided into ten lots as shown on a plat entitled, "Subdivision for Hall & Cox, Realtors", made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, on April 12, 1951, recorded in Plat Book AA at Page 57; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to eliminate the said restriction against sale to Negroes;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That we, the undersigned, being all of the owners of all of the lots shown on the said plat, do hereby mutually covenant and agree that portion of Restriction No. 1 which provides that the property, "shall not be sold to anyone of Negro blood", be eliminated from said restrictions and the said restrictions, as amended, shall provide as follows:

- 1. Said property shall be used for residential purposes only.
- 2. No home shall be erected on said property costing less than \$3500.00.
- 3. Sanitary toilets must be installed and no open front toilets shall be used.
- 4. No hogs or hog pens shall be kept or built upon said premises.
