WHEREAS, on March 14, 1919, a certain agreement was entered into between W. P. Childers, H. T. Mills and A. D. L. Barksdale concerning the rights of said parties as adjoining owners to an alley-way extending East from the East side of Laurens Street in the block between West Washington Street and West Coffee Street in the City of Greenville, said agreement being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 37, at page 531, and

WHEREAS, Thomason Realty Company is the successor in title to the property which was owned by W. P. Childers and H. T. Mills is the successor in title to that portion of the property which was owned by A. D. L. Barksdale at the time the aforementioned agreement was entered into, and

WHEREAS, some question has arisen as to the exact location of the alley referred to in said agreement and on account thereof the parties hereto have had a recent survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service, March 23, 1953, showing the exact location of the alley as now used by the parties entitled thereto, said plat now being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book GG, at page 13,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and in consideration of the further sum of \$1.00 to each of us hand paid by the other party hereto, the receipt whereof is hop acknowledged, we, the undersigned, do hereby mutually agree that the exact location of the alley referred to in the agreement made between W. P. Childers, et al, on March 14, 1919, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.
