Being bounded on the north and west by other lands of the grantor, on the east by the land of P. W. Strange and on the south by the land of Duke Power Company, BEGINNING at a concrete monument at the northwesterly corner of the lot conveyed to Duke Power Company by J. B. Culbertson by deed dated February 24, 1950, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in deed book 403 at page 301, and running thence N. 9° 15' W., 200.0 ft. to a stake; thence N. 79° 44' E. 838.8 ft. to a stake in the line of the land of P. W. Strange; thence S. 4° 57' E. 200.8 ft. to a concrete monument at the northeasterly corner of said lot of Duke Power Company; thence along the land of Duke Power Company S. 79° 44' W., 823.7 ft. to the point of BEGINNING, containing 3.82 acres, more or less, being shown within red lines on print dated May 4, 1953, hereto attached and made a part hereof, and being a part of a tract of land conveyed to J.
